

## **Player Centered vs Command Style Development**

## **Roles Defined:**

Coach's Role

In the player centered approach:

Focus is the Player Creates a challenging game environment Provides options Asks players what they think Develops Players

In the "command style":

Focus is the Coach Creates exercises and directs session Provides solutions Tells players what to think Develops Clones

Player's Role

In the player centered approach:

Primarily learn from playing the game Focus = Playing Solve Soccer Problems

In the "command style":

Primarily learn from the coach Focus = Coach's Expectations Execute coach's direction

The goal of all of the Youth Development Program is to use a player centered approach to produce players that:

Expresses individuality

Thinks independently

Understands options

Solves problems
